4 interlocking suitcase straps of different colours and with different inscriptions were hung on a door coat rack, which in turn hangs on a strip attached to the wall. They have been left hanging and I want to know what they are holding together. This has been added to the otherwise empty room and those 4 to 25 (people), middle aged but young looking, can't enter but can only watch from outside through the window (they are 'pushed to the outside'<sup>1</sup>), even if the right way to say this would be to look at because nothing is moving and it's art. So what is moving anyway? The non-existent suitcases out of the closed door? The aeroplane in the sky? Time that moves on, regardless of whether everything in the room stands still? Actually it must be a circular motion, because 'wherever there is circular motion, there is also centrifugal force.'<sup>2</sup>

Then we go down. It could start all over again or continue, but for those who were just visiting, probably somewhere else.

*If I now place the two lines as a cross on the circle, then I have four equal parts. 4/4. A fraction. The life line on one side (as in palmistry) and a tip on the other side, which points in a different direction for each part.*

*The nursery school teacher says that if you tie a belt around the zero, it becomes an eight. Because of all the sky, I immediately think of a horizontal 8.*
